Subject: 2018 HUTF Inventory Report

Request and Recommendation

To authorize the Chairman to sign the 2018 Arapahoe County Road Inventory and Road System Change Report with corresponding road maps for transmittal to the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT). Recommend signing in February, 2018 to insure prompt delivery of Highway Users Trust Fund (HUTF) money to Arapahoe County.

Background

Section 43-2-120 (5) (a-b), C.R.S., requires each county to certify to CDOT any changes in the County Road System Inventory as of December 31st of the previous year. All additions and deletions to the County road system are to be reported as well as any changes in surface type, surface width, roadway condition, and system designation.

This information is used to determine Arapahoe County's share of the HUTF distribution each month. Sixty percent of HUTF funds in excess of \$86,700,000 are allocated to counties in proportion to the adjusted lane-miles of county roads in each county. Ten percent is allocated in proportion to the surface area of bridge decks and thirty percent in proportion to motor vehicle registrations in the county.

CDOT has requested these documents before the statutory due date of March 1, 2019. Changes to the the previous years Inventory are effective from July 1st until June 30th, State Fiscal Year (FY), with payments adjusted accordingly.

Fiscal Impact

Arapahoe County received \$7.22 million in HUTF monies from the State of Colorado in the FY 2016, \$7.35 million in FY 2017, and \$7.44 million in FY 2018. The HUTF funds are deposited in the Road and Bridge Account.
