

**RESOLUTION NO.** It was moved by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_ and duly seconded by Commissioner \_\_\_\_\_ to allocate up to \$450,000 of Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act funding for three vulnerable population reimbursement/payment programs: 1) reimbursement of out-of-home placement costs for youth in custody of the Department of Human Services who have either been diagnosed with, are exhibiting symptoms of, or have been potentially exposed to, COVID-19; and 2) payment of the costs of GPS monitor rentals for defendants that have GPS monitoring as a condition of their bond but are unable to pay for the monitoring due to unemployment as a result of COVID-19; and 3) pay rent, mortgage, and utility payments for eligible citizens that have become unemployed or underemployed due to COVID-19; further, the Board hereby finds such expenses are reasonably necessary due to the COVID-19 emergency, in order to continue to serve and protect vulnerable populations, and prevent the spread of COVID-19, within Arapahoe County during the emergency.
