**Subject:** Resolution re: CARES Act Fund Agreements for Business Grant & Support Programs

### **Request and Recommendation**

On June 16, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 200334, which approved the “Advance Arapahoe” and “Retrain Arapahoe” programs, and allocated a total of up to \$9 million of Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act funding to the programs. This proposed resolution was drafted for the purpose of supplementing Resolution No. 200334 to clarify the public purposes behind the approval and funding of the “Advance Arapahoe” and “Retrain Arapahoe” programs, which are to help alleviate the economic hardship caused to businesses and individuals by the government issued public health orders, to help keep the economy and employment opportunities within Arapahoe County strong, and to ensure that businesses are adequately protecting citizens from the coronavirus. It is recommended by the County Attorney that the Board adopt this resolution to fully document its purpose in adopting Resolution No. 200334 and approving the funding for the “Advance Arapahoe” and “Retrain Arapahoe” programs.
