Building Inspector in Custody for Burglary and Theft

On Thursday, September 12, 2013, at about 5:40 p.m., deputies of the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office responded to a residence in Unincorporated Arapahoe County regarding an allegation of a burglary that occurred earlier in the day.

The female victim reported that she was having her basement re-modeled and the contractor was scheduled to meet with an Arapahoe County building inspector, during the morning hours of September 12, 2013, in order to accomplish required inspections of the construction project. As the re-modeling project was on-going, the contractor and workers had arranged for regular access to the basement through an unlocked basement door. In order to ensure the security of the occupied portion of the home, an inside door from the basement to the main floor was to be kept locked.

On Thursday, September 12, 2013, at about 8:30 a.m., while the victim was in her bed, she heard the doorbell ring, but did not answer the door. She then heard the inside door from the basement open and observed a male subject enter her bedroom. The male suspect was seen walking directly to the victim's dressers, inside the master bedroom of the home, and began opening drawers. As the bedroom was dark, the suspect seemed unaware of the victim's presence. As the suspect removed an undergarment from a dresser drawer, the victim announced her presence. Upon hearing the victim's voice, the suspect ran from the bedroom.

On September 13, 2013, at about 10:30 a.m., Iringan was taken into custody, without incident, by Investigators of the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office. Iringan is being held at the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office Detention Facility on a \$200,000.00 bond, pending the filing of formal criminal charges. Iringan will be charged with violations of:

C.R.S. 18-4-203 Second Degree Burglary (Class 3 Felony)
and
C.R.S. 18-4-401 Theft (Misdemeanor)

Iringan has been an Arapahoe County employee since October 13, 1998, and has been assigned as a building inspector for that entire period. Consistent with the personnel policies of Arapahoe County, Iringan has been placed on paid administrative leave, pending the outcome of this matter.

As a result of the continuing investigation related to this incident, multiple pieces of evidence have been recovered to include undergarments, suggesting additional victims may exist.
