Sheriff Promotes Four Command Staff Members

Undersheriff Perea started with the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office in 1986, and has served in the following areas: Patrol Services; Investigation Services; the Professional Standards Bureau; and, the Detention and Administrative Services Bureau. Undersheriff Perea earned a Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice from Metropolitan State College of Denver, graduated from Northwestern University School of Police Staff and Command, attended the Federal Bureau of Investigation National Academy, attended the Daniels College of Business Public Safety Leadership Program and served as an assessor for the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA). Undersheriff Perea will be responsible for the day-to-day administrative management and operations of the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office to include patrol, investigations, budget and logistics, human resources, professional standards and detention services.

Sheriff Walcher appointed Glenn B. Thompson as Bureau Chief of the Public Safety Bureau, where he will be responsible for the daily operations of the Patrol and Investigation Services sections. Chief Thompson began his career at the Sheriff's Office as an Explorer and was hired full time in 1988.
