**ARAPAHOE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE INVESTIGATION  
RESULTS IN FIVE INDICTMENTS IN 2011 HOMICIDE**

On December 26, 2011, at about 3:10 A.M., the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office received a 911 call of shots fired in the 1100 block of South Xenia Street, in Unincorporated Arapahoe County. Upon arrival, deputies found a 43-year-old male, deceased in his vehicle. It was apparent that the victim died from gunshot wounds. At the time, there were no known suspects and no apparent motive for the shooting.

The victim was identified as:

**Malual, Youn**  
**Age 43**

During the subsequent investigation, Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office investigators determined that just after 3:00 A.M. on the morning of December 26, 2011, Mr. Malual returned home from work and parked his vehicle in the apartment parking lot in the 1100 block of South Xenia Street. Investigators further determined that Mr. Malual was not the intended victim of the shooting. Mr. Malual was shot and killed because he was mistaken for an intended victim who lived in the same apartment complex as Mr. Malual.

After a thorough and extensive investigation by the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office and the 18<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Attorney's Office, a case was presented to the 18<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Grand Jury in June, 2014. On July 25, 2014, the Grand Jury returned indictments on the following individuals for their involvement in the murder of Mr. Malual:

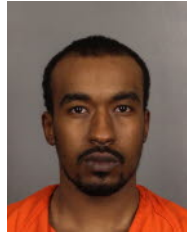

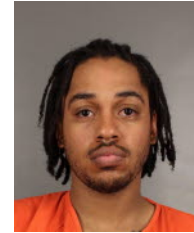

At the time the Grand Jury indictments were issued, Devon Grant-Washington was already in the custody of the Colorado Department of Corrections. Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office investigators, with the assistance of the Rocky Mountain Safe Streets Task Force Fugitive Unit, the Aurora Police Department and the Denver Police Department, have located and arrested the four other suspects in this case. All five suspects are currently in custody.

Devon Grant-Washington, Brandon Jackson, Urocca Guyton and Amin El-Howeris have been charged with Murder in the First Degree, C.R.S. 18-3-102.

Bruce Roberts has been charged with Accessory to Murder in the First Degree, C.R.S. 18-8-105.

According to Sheriff Dave Walcher, "Due to an incredible amount of work and perseverance on the part of our investigators, and great cooperation and support of the District Attorney's Office, our community will be safer and now we can seek justice for Mr. Malual."

District Attorney George Brauchler stated, "It is important that the public presumes that the defendants in this crime are innocent of the allegations against them until proven guilty. Thanks to the tireless efforts of the dedicated law enforcement officers at the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office and members of my office's Cold Case Unit, Mr. Malual and his family have been able to see this first step in a process that may help them get the justice they deserve."
