## **Traffic and closure impact to residents for Rocky Mountain Air Show**

*Delays expected May 29-31 on Quincy Avenue; Aurora Reservoir Park open only to ticketholders*

LITTLETON, CO --- The City of Aurora is set to host the Rocky Mountain Air Show May 29-31 at the Aurora Reservoir. With 70,000 spectators expected during the three-day event, area residents and visitors may experience traffic delays and closures.

Air Show activities will take place at Aurora Reservoir Park which will be CLOSED for public access for this special event. A Rocky Mountain Air Show ticket will be required for entry to all areas of the park.

The park is the only closure associated with the event. No street closures are expected.

Heavy traffic or delays may occur in both directions on Quincy Avenue. Ticket holders will access event parking from Quincy, on to Powhaton Road and proceed to designated parking areas at the Arapahoe County Fairgrounds and Arapahoe Horse Park. Shuttles will transport guests from parking areas to the Park.

The Arapahoe County Fairgrounds is not hosting public events during this time.

Parking will be strictly prohibited and enforced along Quincy Avenue, Gun Club Road and E-470. Aurora Police and the Arapahoe County Sheriff Deputies will patrol the event perimeter to ensure as little interruption of your daily comings and goings as possible.
