Shooting Suspect Arrested without Incident

The man suspected in a shooting in the 5500 block of S. Jebel Way that occurred just after 5:15 p.m. on Tuesday, Sept. 8 was taken safely into custody at 4:15 p.m. today. Jonathan Ryan was arrested after deputies received a tip that he had returned to the residence on S. Jebel Way.

Overnight, investigators obtained an arrest warrant for Ryan for the charges of Criminal Attempt First Degree Murder; First Degree Assault; and Crimes against an At Risk Adult. The victim in this case is Ryan's 71-year-old father. They also obtained a search warrant for the residence and executed that search warrant early this morning before clearing the scene.

Just before 3 p.m. today, deputies were notified by a neighbor that Ryan had returned to the residence and they believed he was inside. Deputies responded to the location and set up a perimeter. Communications sent out an Everbridge (911 call back system) to 37 phone numbers asking residents to shelter in place.

Prior to deputies entering the home, Ryan came out and he was arrested without incident. Deputies remained at the scene and will apply for a second search warrant for the home since the suspect went inside. They will also apply for a search warrant for his vehicle.

The victim of the shooting was transported to an area hospital where he is being treated. His current condition is not known. It is not clear what led up to the shooting as Ryan and his father were the only two at home at the time of the incident.

Ryan's booking photo is not available at this time.
