CSU-Extension teaching Incredible Wearables for Youth National Science Day *Youth invited to participate in 2017 4-H Youth National Science Day experiment*

LITTLETON, CO --- Wearable technology is becoming more common every day. From smart phones, to fitness trackers, engineers use technology to create problem-solving solutions in fun, wearable packages.

Arapahoe County CSU-Extension 4-H is inviting youth to participate in the 2017 4-H National Youth Science Day experiment Nov. 8. Incredible Wearables will be held 6 – 8 p.m. at the Arapahoe County Fairgrounds, 25690 E. Quincy Ave., Aurora, 80016. The cost is \$5 per student and includes a pizza dinner and supplies for the project.

Youth in grades 4 – 12 will explore engineering, design and technology. Teams will work together to design their own wearable fitness tracker.

4-H National Youth Science Day is the world's largest youth-led engineering design challenge, drawing nearly 100,000 participants in 2016. Arapahoe County 4-H youth complete numerous STEM projects in robotics, agricultural science and rocketry annually. 4-H enrollment for 2018 is open through April 1 for new members.
