Voter Service and Polling Centers open Oct. 30

Citizens must live in one of 18 coordinating jurisdictions in order to vote in this election

Littleton, CO – The Arapahoe County Clerk and Recorder's Office will open four Voter Service and Polling Centers Monday for the 2017 Coordinated Election. Citizens may visit these locations to cast a ballot only if they live in one of [18 participating jurisdictions](#) with a race or question on the ballot. Approximately 55,000 voters in the county do *not* live in a coordinating jurisdiction and are not eligible to vote in this election.

Eligible voters may visit any Voter Service and Polling Center between Oct. 30 and Nov. 7 to register to vote, update registration, drop off a voted mail ballot, request a new or replacement ballot, or vote on an accessible electronic tablet. All locations will be open 10 a.m. – 7 p.m. weekdays until Election Day, as well as 9 a.m. – 1 p.m., Saturday, Nov. 4. and 7 a.m. – 7 p.m., Election Day, Tuesday, Nov. 7. Locations include:

Halloween is Last Day to Return Ballot by Mail

Voters who plan to return their ballot by mail should send it by Tuesday, Oct. 31 to ensure it arrives by Election Day. Please affix 49 cents paid postage (or one Forever stamp). After Halloween, voters are encouraged to instead deliver their voted ballots to one of the 24, [24-hour ballot boxes](#) in Arapahoe County.

Turnout Nearly 5% To-Date

More than 20,700 mail ballots have been cast in Arapahoe County, which is 6.4% of nearly 324,000 eligible voters. For historical comparison, final turnout in the County's 2015 Coordinated Election was 30.02%.

Jurisdictions with Race or Question

You are eligible to vote in this election if you live in one of these jurisdictions with a race or ballot question:

- **Cities and Towns:** City of Aurora, City of Centennial, City of Englewood, City of Greenwood Village, City of Littleton, City of Sheridan, Town of Foxfield, or
- **School Districts:** Aurora Public Schools, Bennett School District 29J, Byers School District 32J, Englewood School District, Sheridan School District No 2, or

- **Special Districts:** Bennett Fire Protection District No. 7, Sable Altura Fire Protection District, Sheridan Sanitation District No. 1, South Suburban Park and Recreation District, Strasburg Fire Protection District No. 8 and Valley Sanitation District.
