Experian Verify provides secure employment and/or income information to our credentialed verifiers (mortgage companies, lenders, pre-employment screeners, etc.) on behalf of your employer. You may view your report and control access to your information using the Experian Verify employee portal.

How to Register:

- 1** Visit www.experianverify.com and choose “I am an Employee”
- 2** Enter the following:
 - Access Code: **E3FBFA3B**
 - Full Social Security Number
 - Full Name
 - Date of Birth
 - Email Address
- 3** Click **Create an Employee Account**. A password setup link will be sent to your email address. Click the link to create a password and activate your account.
- 4** Log in with your credentials
